Back in April, I met with a client that had lived in a house in pleasant grove for about fifteen years. The house was decorated in jewel tones throughout and the owner was ready for a change.

She had just remodeled the kitchen with sage green walls, countertops and new glass tile backsplash in greens and golds, and the dining room needed to be updated to go with the kitchen. The original burgundy wallpaper in the dining room was replaced with a green and gold harlequin diamond designed paper, which looks wonderful! A new paint color, blonde, by Sherwin Williams, was chosen for the entry and living room. The next step was selecting a new drapery fabric for new window treatments to bring an updated style to the room. We decided on a gold and green "Silk Look" with gold tassel trim on straight panels,

and we installed them on a decorative wooden pole. Nice finials and rings on the pole helped to update the look. We also chose a new fabric for the dining room chair seats. Originally, they were very plain- a chocolate brown fabric with green and gold floral design really brought the chairs to life! The client then chose an area rug which really brought together the entire room.

The next month, we decided to rearrange the living room. We knew we needed a big piece of furniture on the big wall so a new T.V. cabinet was purchased. The leather sofa and love seat were the original burgundy color so we decided to recover the french chairs to update the look. Originally navy blue and burgundy, the chairs were truly transformed by a floral print with burgundy and gold tones. We also recovered some
